Camp Niwana is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items, though our staff will do their best to ensure your campers take proper care of all of their belongings. Luggage is subject to search as necessary and staff may be required to store any prohibited items to return to the parents at the end of the session. In the extremely unlikely event that a camper is a danger to themselves or others, he/she may be sent home immediately with no refund.

What to Leave at Home:

- ❌ Guns, knives, weapons of any type
- ❌ Food, Candy, Gum and drinks
- ❌ Hair dryers, curling irons, flat irons
- ❌ Jewelry or sentimental items
- ❌ Electronics of any type – no cell phones, laptops, tablets, ipods, radios, digital cameras, gaming devices, and nothing internet capable

These items need left at home in order to protect them from the heat, humidity, sand, water and other substances they may come in contact with at camp. We also want to preserve the camp “bubble” in the natural environment to allow them full enjoyment of what is going on, instead of what other people are doing. Plenty of pictures will be taken by the staff, and campers can use disposable cameras as well, to document their fun at camp.

Our dress code can be summed up with the words “Wholesome Fun” and we ask that you pack accordingly. In all your clothing choices, remember that camp is not a fashion show and you should bring things you don’t mind getting dirty or lost. Questionable dress or appearance will be referred to the Camp Director. We are not able to list all possible things which might become a nuisance or safety concern at camp, but will work to eliminate the situation before it becomes an issue. In all situations the Camp Director’s decision will be final.
